

Tuition Assistance Provided for 2017—18 School Year

Beginning in 2012, the Bishop's Education Fund has provided tuition assistance to hundreds of families choosing to enroll their children in any of the sixteen Catholic school systems in our diocese.

The fund especially targets those families who may not receive funding from the Monsignor Lafferty Tuition Foundation due to income eligibility guidelines.

As more and more families demonstrate a financial need for tuition assistance (current estimates exceed \$4 million), it is the goal of the diocese to increase both the funding available as well as the number of recipients from the Bishop's Education Fund.
